

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Mission Support Alliance LLC Health and Welfare Benefit Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Mission Support Alliance LLC Health and Welfare Benefit Plan, EIN 30-0419594, Plan No. 501, for period August 24, 2009 through December 31, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Washington Dental Services, Group Health Cooperative, and Life Insurance Company of North America to pay health, dental, life insurance, temporary disability, long-term disability, business travel accident and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009 were \$418,481.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$39,941 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$36,622.
