We recently learned that a member of the MSA family, who works at 609A, has reported a positive test result for the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The employee's last day of work was April 9.

The office where the individual works is currently restricted and is being cleaned in accordance with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines. Our ongoing, enhanced cleaning protocols continue across the site per CDC guidelines. MSA and the Hanford Site will continue to follow guidance from the CDC and state and county public health agencies.

Out of respect for the privacy of the employee and their loved ones, we will not be releasing their name. The Benton Franklin Health District (BFHD) is responsible for direct contact with those who have tested positive regarding next steps.
