During the week of 27 July, the Hanford Site will remain in Phase 1 operations with a small increase in the number of onsite workers. The use of established COVID-19 protocols remains important in protecting the health of our workforce.

Hanford Site leadership will continue to monitor and evaluate local and state COVID-19 data and trends, testing availability, and health care system capacity as we progress our important mission and support our community recovery efforts.
