MSA Announces Recipients for Employee Dependent and Co-op Student Intern Scholarship Program

RICHLAND, Wash. – Mission Support Alliance, LLC (MSA), a Lockheed Martin/Jacobs/WSI Company, announced the winners of the MSA Employee Dependent & Cooperative Student Intern Scholarship Program for the 2013/2014 academic year. Employees, friends and family members gathered to congratulate the scholarship recipients at a reception held at the MSA headquarters on June 25.

Twenty-one students each received an award of \$1,000. An additional seven co-op interns each received a \$1,500 scholarship.
